Drama Games – Bianca Power

We all know that Pre-school boys and girls are drama queens. Be quietly surprised at your child's use of dramatic flair for make believe fun.

Kindergarten – Yr. 2 Students

Science Fun – Fizzics Education

This workshop will introduce young children to science using familiar toys and materials. The aim of the course is to develop in children an enthusiasm for further learning in science and encourage active exploration of their world. Students will know and understand that

- pushes and pulls can make things move and stop.
- living things and machines need energy to do things.
- different senses can be used in observing.
- discoveries can be made through play, exploring and experimenting.

Kindergarten – Yr. 2 Students

Join our four great facilitators and immerse yourself in the creative world of make believe. Use your imagination to design and make your own puppet. Learn the different aspects of puppet making and puppetry. See how personality and style can be incorporated into your design.

Yr. 2 to Yr. 4 Students

Stars and Planets – Fizzics Education

Students investigate our Universe and space exploration techniques in this hands-on workshop. What did the big bang really look like? How are the tides formed? Where is Earth in the Solar System? What technological developments were necessary to allow astronauts to work and survive outside of Earth's atmosphere? How do we observe distant galaxies? What is our atmosphere made of anyway? Students will gain an appreciation of astronomy and gain insight into our place in the universe.

Yr. 2 to Yr. 4 Students

Art Adventure – Madeline Frew

Use your creativity to explore different art methods and effects. Use a variety of mediums to develop your works of art. Bring your ideas and imagination and enjoy the support and stimulation from the facilitator and other participants.

Lego Robotics– Fizzics Education

An interactive hands on workshop designed to demonstrate how a robot really works. Using laptops and the brand new NXT Lego Mindstorms robots, students are asked to complete a variety tasks whilst learning about basic programming. Working in pairs, students are guided step by step on how to program their robot to perform precise movements as well as how to operate environmental sensors such as light and sound.

Digital Story Telling – Mark Stevens
