EXPLORAMA Program – Merrylands – September / October 2010

Day 1 - Tue 28 September 2010

Pre-school - ages 3 to 5 (plus an adult must attend)

Please Note: Workshop runs 9.30am – 12.00pm

Fun with Light and Colour – Cindy

What would life be like without colour? Enjoy some fun hands on activities to get us thinking about light and colour. We will try and create rainbows, mix colours and learn about reflection and refraction! Activities will be messy and parent involvement will be required.

Please note: due to our duty of care and OHS requirements - children under the age of 3 including younger siblings are not able to attend this activity.

Kindergarten Yr. 2 Students – ages 5 to 7 years

Earth Science - Camilla

We live on a planet – the only one that has an atmosphere for us to breathe, a surface on which we can live and animals & plants that provide food for our survival. We will explore those things about our planet that make it able to support life. We will have fun with rocks, volcanoes, soil and water.

Yr. 3 to Yr. 5 Students - ages 8 to 10 years

Surrounded by Science - Adam

Explore the science of all things that flow - from air to water, slime and lava. Make Wind Things to take home and great recipes for formidable slime mix. Create a working model volcano complete with a thixotropic flow.

Yr. 4 to Yr. 7 Students – ages 9 to 13 years

Mighty Machine Challenge - Steve

Investigate the strength of triangles to handle the tension imposed on the catapults and bridge that you design and build using hot glue guns. Learn about deceleration, crumple zones, cushioning and current NASA space missions - and then design, build and test your 'moon lander' spacecraft that will carry a precious egg cargo safely to the ground from a great height.

Day 2 - Tues 5 October 2010

Kindergarten Yr. 2 Students – ages 5 to 7 years

Space Science - Camilla

In this session we will journey from the beginning of the solar system to today –a journey of more than 5 billion years. And in the process we will discover something that Goldilocks discovered –that some places are just too hot, and some places are just too cold...and why Earth got lucky and is just right!

Yr. 3 to Yr. 5 Students - ages 8 to 10 years

Science Toys & Gizmos - Adam

Learn the science behind popular toys and then make your own to take home. From spinning tops to thaumatropes and Bernoulli basketball to clucking duck cups - use your new scientific knowledge to put on a science show!

Yr. 4 to Yr. 7 Students - ages 9 to 13 years

Lego Robotics - Amanda

This popular interactive hands on workshop returns! Using laptops and the brand new NXT Lego Mindstorm robots, students are asked to complete a variety of tasks whilst learning about basic computer programming. Working in pairs, students are guided step by step on how to program their robot to perform precise movements as well as how to operate environmental sensors such as light and sound.
